

## **Expected impact of the project and dissemination**

The project is modelled this way: the direct target group are professionals, public officers, policy makers, CSO representatives who take part in international events (all together in five events around 430 participants!).

Each of the events is followed by evaluation and dissemination activities to be performed by the partners in regional and local indirect target groups – both policy/decision makers (Councils, politicians, staff), and general public (citizens). This model ensures both a multiplier effect and sustainability.

CITIZENS DIALOGUES will be performed during the events which means that we will try to involve high-level politicians operating on European level to join us during these events. In this way, our regional/local concerns will gain a European dimension.

IN CASE OF EACH OF THE PROJECT PARTNER, the key impact on indirect groups will go in three ways:

- -"Horizontal"- to colleagues, staff members, representatives of different sectors. Institutions will be informed and supported with new solutions.
- -"Bottom-up" to high policy/decision makers and councils. Policies revision. IMPORTANT! Some partners involve Committees, Councils and units that advise and follow up implementation of laws and other regulations on their territory in order to have formal impact on these matters.
- -Among citizens, including groups at risk of exclusion/poverty.- HOW CAN YOU DO THIS?
